- Clubs will select their own teams. All entrants must be financial club members.


#### There will be four age grades:

- Young'uns (MW10 MW12) White and Yellow course runners
- Junior (MW14 MW18)
- Open (MW20 MW40)
- Master (MW50 +)

- To qualify for the trophy, clubs must have as a minimum, one Young'uns, one Junior team, one Open team and one Master team.
- Points will be determined by placing's in each grade. 10 points for 1st down to 1 point for 10th. Only the clubs highest point score in each grade will count
- Format will be 3 sequential legs of approximately equal lengths in a sprint format with a winning time of between 12 & 15 minutes per leg. Cost will be \$8 per junior and \$15 for the others. SportIdent hire is \$3. AOC will invoice clubs after the event to recoup the entry fees.






# Multi-level section – please read carefully

In this event we will be introducing a multi-level area of the map.




On the main side of the map you will see a control leading in to the Car Park.



On the reverse side of the map there will be 4 levels with legs between controls on different levels of the Car Park.


Controls will be listed with their number first and the box number  $2^{nd}$  – no control descriptions



Stairwells and ramps will be connected by the same letter and colour. Stairwell A from level 4 connects to stairwell A on level 3. Ramp G connects with ramp G

There are 9 different connecting stairwells and ramps in the car park complex

### Additional sections of the course



Artificial barriers. We will be adding an artificial barrier on the map. Signified by a blocked passage – which will introduce additional complex route choice legs



Out of bounds area. There is a specific section of the campus with a wall that is impassable on the map but looks potentially passable at one end. As a result we have excluded any doubt by mapping an out of bounds area and having this clearly taped off on the day



Graveyard start and transition. We will be introducing a graveyard start for all three legs where the runners start and transition next to a pole with their maps wrapped round their start post.
