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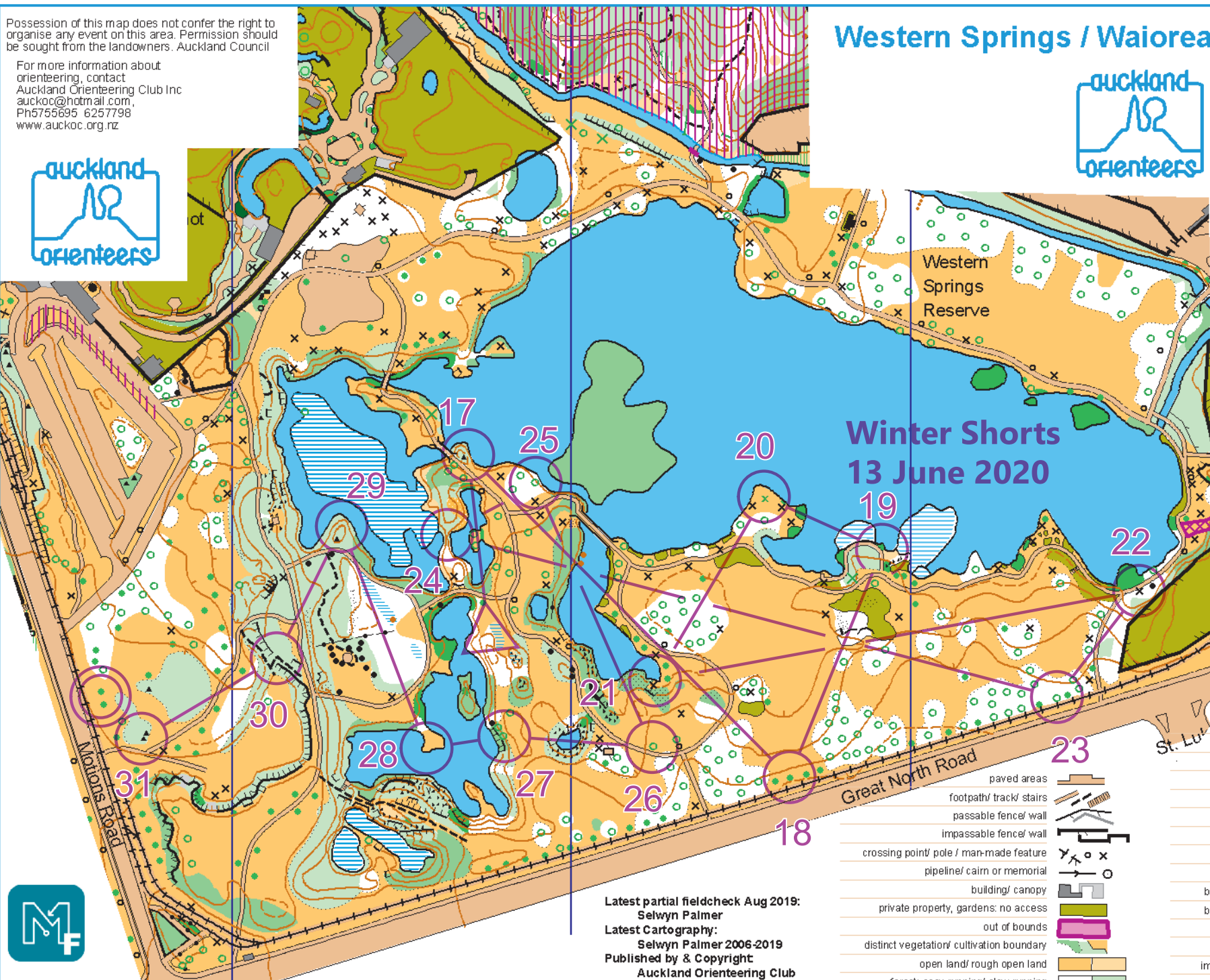
Western Springs / Waiorea (Water of Eels)

- passable fence/ wall
- impassable fence/ wall
- crossing point/ pole / man-made feature
- pipeline/ cairn or memorial
- building/ canopy
- private property, gardens: no access
- out of bounds
- distinct vegetation/ cultivation boundary
- open land/ rough open land
- forest: easy running/ slow running
- vegetation: difficult to run/ fight
- undergrowth: slow running/ difficult to run

- contours - interval 2.0 metres/ cave
- index contour/ form line/ slope line
- normal/ elongated/ knoll
- pit/ small/ large depression
- small/ large erosion gully, or ditch
- earth bank/ broken ground
- small earth wall, rocky pit
